Infrastructure improvement is crucial for advances to be made in all four sectors in Mbola. poor infrastructure in the village which currently hampers disease prevention, efficient energy use and work, as well as access to resources and marketing of products.



We have been working with the community to:

- Locate safe water sources.
- Improve the rural networks.
- Increase access to communication through cell phones and internet connections.
- Improve energy efficiency and transportation (introduction of more efficient stoves, road improvement).
- Increase access to medical care through renovation of four dispensaries and the construction of two new dispensaries within the MVP Cluster.
- Make school structure improvements for a better learning environment.

EDUCATION



Our focus is to improve school facilities, create and support lunch programs, and offer secondary school scholarships to orphans and children from extremely poor families. For 2007 academic year 100 students (45 girls and 55 boys) are benefiting from MVP scholarships program.
